3. The sodium content of a patient's breakfast is as follows: 250 mL 2% milk = 0.12 grams; 2 slices of whole wheat toast = 0.155 grams per slice; margarine = 0.07 grams; and 200 mL apple juice = 0.15 grams. How many grams of sodium did the patient consume?

- a. 1.28 grams b. 0.65 grams
c. 495 grams d. 0.495 grams

4. Rounding the answer off to two decimal places (hundredths), what is the product of 1.82×0.04 ?

7. Arrange the following decimals from *largest* to *smallest*: 1.5, 0.25, 1.025

ANSWER: 1.5, 1.025, 0.25

8. Arrange the following decimals from *largest* to *smallest*: 0.33, 0.045, 0.7

ANSWER: 0.7, 0.33, 0.045

9. Arrange the following fractions from *smallest* to *largest*: $\frac{3}{16}$, $\frac{3}{20}$, $\frac{3}{4}$

ANSWER: $\frac{3}{20}$, $\frac{3}{16}$, $\frac{3}{4}$

10. Arrange the following fractions from *smallest* to *largest*: $\frac{7}{16}$, $\frac{3}{16}$, $\frac{5}{16}$

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ANSWER: $\frac{3}{16}, \frac{5}{16}, \frac{7}{16}$

11. $5\frac{5}{6} + 7\frac{1}{3}$

ANSWER: $5\frac{5}{6} + 7\frac{1}{3} = 5\frac{5}{6} + 7\frac{2}{6} = 12\frac{7}{6} = 13\frac{1}{6}$

12. $2\frac{1}{2} \div \frac{3}{4}$

ANSWER: $2\frac{1}{2} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{5}{2} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{5}{2} \times \frac{4}{3} = \frac{10}{3} = 3\frac{1}{3}$

13. $8\frac{5}{12} - 3\frac{3}{4}$

ANSWER: $8\frac{5}{12} - 3\frac{3}{4} = 8\frac{5}{12} - 3\frac{9}{12} = 7\frac{17}{12} - 3\frac{9}{12} = 4\frac{8}{12} = 4\frac{2}{3}$

14. $\frac{3}{4} \div \frac{5}{8}$

ANSWER: $\frac{3}{4} \div \frac{5}{8} = \frac{3}{4} \times \frac{8}{5} = \frac{6}{5} = 1\frac{1}{5}$

15. 2.7×0.02

ANSWER: 0.05
