Software — program or collection of programs that enable the hardware to process data; part of the IT components/platform

Database — collection of related files or tables containing data; part of the IT components/platform

Network — connecting system (wireline or wireless) that enables multiple computers to share resources; part of the IT components/platform

Procedures — the instructions for combining the above components to process information and generate the desired output (also called IT services)

People — use the hardware and software, interface with it, or utilize its output (also called IT personnel)

Video — Blockbuster was disrupted by Netflix and went out of business (except one store); Netflix has the largest global subscriber base of any video service with 167 million subscribers
